INSTALLATION GUIDE

2018 - CURRENT FORD EXPEDITION SELF SUPPORTING GUNRACK BASE 4GRK581802

THESE COMPONENTS ARE REQUIRED TO INSTALL THE SELF SUPPORTING GUNRACK BASE



I. The following tools will be required to complete the installation

- A. Drill or Impact Driver
- C. TORX BITS

B. Hex drive bits

D. Ratchet and socket set

II. Read all instructions and refer to the Parts List to ensure all parts were received.

WARNING: Locate all wire

Locate all wiring, fuel lines, brake lines, coolant lines, and refrigerant lines before drilling any holes or installing any self-drilling fasteners.

III. Assemble the Base

- A. Locate the Driver Front Leg [3GRK812102] and (2) Button Head screws [3X149].
- B. Align the Driver Front Leg with the corresponding holes on the driver side of the Base as shown in Figure 1. Ensure that the two widest holes in the base are opposite the front legs (refer to exploded view on the last page).
- C. Using a 3/16" Hex drive install the (2) screws gathered in step A.
- D. Repeat steps A C on the passenger side of the base using the Passenger Front Leg [3GRK812103] and (2) Button Head screws [3X149].



IV. Install the Base

- A. Slide middle seat of second row seat completely rearward to expose hardware securing front of slider rails.
- B. Using torx bit, remove 2 bolts securing front of slider rails for the middle seat (1 bolt per rail). These bolts will NOT be reused. (Fig. 2A).
- C. Slide tabs of 3GRK581804 into slider rails. (Fig. 2B).
- Using supplied 3x517 bolts, loosely secure rear bracket through slider rails where factory hardware was removed.
- E. Using torx bit, remove rear inboard bolts from the front driver and passenger seat





- F. Place the tabs of the Front Legs onto the driver and passenger front seat mounts (Fig. 2C).
- G. Loosely reinstall the (2) OEM bolts removed in steps E back into their respective holes. Reapply thread locker to OEM bolts as necessary.
- H. Use the remaining (4) 3X149 screws to secure the rear bracket to the main base. Tighten all 4 screws.
- I. Fully tighten down OEM bolts in front, and supplied bolts in rear.
