

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
## THESE COMPONENTS ARE REQUIRED TO INSTALL THE PRO-GARD TRUNK TRAY SYSTEM



- I. Refer to the diagram on the last page of these instructions to verify all parts were received.
- II. The following tools will be required to complete the installation.

Electric Drill 3/8" socket w/ adapter for drill #2 Phillips Screwdriver 7/16" socket with 3/8" drive and handle 3/16" Allen wrench 1/2" open/box end wrench


- III. Rear Support Assembly
  - A. Drop down upper trunk liner to expose access holes under the rear deck (Fig. 1).
  - B. Install "U" bolts (13) as shown through the access holes and down into OEM holes. Secure in place with pushnuts (15).




- C. Replace upper trunk liner. The "U" bolts will protrude through the liner.
- D. Install the rear support as shown with four 1/4" flat washers (6) and four 1/4-20 whiz nuts (5).

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- IV. Mounting Bracket Assembly
  - A. Remove rear seat back. (Note: If installing trunk tray in vehicle with Pro-gard transport seat, trunk tray must be installed before seat). fIG. 2a
  - B. Install driver side mounting bracket (7) with two 1/4-20 x 5/8" Phillips Truss head screws (14), two 1/4" flat washers (6) and two 1/4-20 whiz nuts (5) (Fig. 2a.).
  - C. Insure that mounting bracket is perpendicular to rear support and install two 1/4" x 3/4" self drilling screws (4) (Fig. 2a).




TOWARD THE REAR



- D. Place spreader bar (16) in place and screw one 1/4" x 3/4" self drilling screw (4) into flange as shown in Fig. 2b.
- E. Repeat steps A D for passenger side using spreader bar (16) to determine spacing of the mounting brackets at the back of the trunk tray.

- V. Installing the Side Rails
  - A. Using the 5/16-18 x 3/4" BSHCS (10), 1/4" flat washer (6) & 5/16-18 nut (11), mount the side rails and adjust to the desired height.



- VI. Trunk Tray
  - A. Slide trunk tray into tracks on side rails and push in until tray latches lock. Tray can be installed either with the sides up to form a tray or with the sides down to form a shelf.
