Choosing The Right Gun Rack

STEP 1: Determine the vehicle this gun rack will be mounted to

STEP 2: Determine the location of the gun rack in the vehicle

- Tri-Lock Partition and Self-Supporting Mounts will not need a Gun Rack Order Form, but lock override key type will need to be identifed when selecting part numbers
- Standard Partition Mounts, Self-supporting Mounts, Trunk, and all other applications will need to proceed to steps 3 -5 and fill-out a Gun Rack Order Form

STEP 3: What type of weapon(s) will be housed in the gun rack


 Indicate the type of weapon(s) to be housed in the gun rack so that the lock heads, guards, and brackets can be properly assembled to fit the weapon

STEP 4: Choose a lock override key option

- We offer three styles: Handcuff Key, Straight Key, or Vending Style Key
- · Identify preference on "Gun Rack Order Form"

STEP 5: Weapon(s) Accessories

- On the "Gun Rack Order Form" identify the types and locations of all accessories.
 This will determine where we place the lock heads, guards, and brackets on the gun rack
- Photographs of the weapon fully equipped with the accessories is the optimal way to guarantee a secure fit








GUN RACK WEAPON MOUNTING OPTIONS










